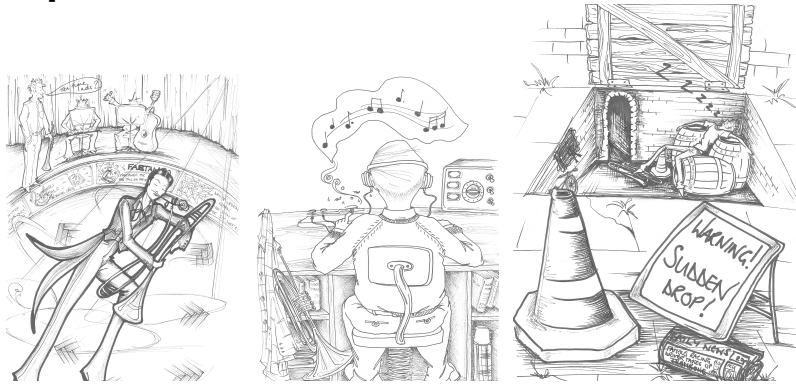


Downloading
